 - a) You will only be awarded up to 5 PC a year

XI. IEA New Business Item

- A. New ByLaw Amendment
 - 1. Restructuring of dues
 - a) All members pay the same dues amount flat rate
 - b) New structure is based on credible earning
 - (1) The more you make the more you pay
 - (2) Doing this in the name of equity
 - (3) Will need a ²/₃ vote to pass the RA
 - (4) How do they get more money to pay for expenses
- B. IEA is tracking reasons for dropping out of union
 - 1. There has not been a lot of growth over the last 15 years, it is steady
- XII. RA Agenda
- XIII. Staffing timeline
 - A. Dishonorable Dismissal Cannot be rehired generally
 - 1. Pretenure 1, 2, 3 do not need a reason for release
 - 2. Pretenure 4 do need a reason
 - 3. No requirement to let teachers know beforehand about being released
 - B. Honorable Dismissal
 - 1. Meeting about what that means and when and how to reenter U-46
 - C. Reduction in Force (RIF)
 - 1. May be targeted
 - 2. Honorable Dismissals can be rehired
